



AMERICORPS SERVICE MEMBERS, Hoopa Americorps Program, TEMP, F/T, Bi-Weekly Living Stipend. Corps members will serve 1700 hours and complete the full ten months of the program year. They will receive a student loan deferment, work experience, training, and a bi-weekly living stipend of \$599.20. Upon successfully completion of term of service, members will receive an education award of \$4,725.00. A corps member will spend 80% of the time performing community service duties to the Hoopa Valley and surrounding communities. Corps members will spend 20% in training and personal developments. Cut, deliver, and stack wood for elders; Cutting and stacking of brush; Beautification projects, Event set-up & clean up; working in adverse weather conditions. On certain occasions member will be required to work on weekends, evenings, holidays, power outages, etc., depending on the schedule and current events. Other duties may be assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must have a High School Diploma or equivalent upon entering Americorps *or*
- Agree to obtain HS diploma or its equivalent prior to using the education award.
- Must be able to move or lift up to 50 lbs frequently.
- Will be subject to a background check.
