# Hazardous Conditions



For the following areas until midnight:

### TRINITY COUNTY: Hyampom and Hayfork

Smoke levels in these areas have been classified as *Hazardous*. Smoke in this area is creating a health hazard. Please watch for updates.

People are recommended to restrict outdoor activity.

Symptoms that may be related to excess smoke exposure include:

- Repeated coughing
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Wheezing
- Chest tightness or pain
- Palpitations
- Nausea or unusual fatigue
- Lightheadedness
