



EARN GREAT REWARDS.

During service, corps members benefit from the variety of trainings, work experience, as well as from:

- Free Room & Board—Corps members share a room with another member from a different area.
- Bi-Weekly Living Stipend—A modest living stipend is given bi-weekly to pay for personal needs.
- Full-Time Child Care Paid For—Through the National Association of Child Care Resource & Referral Agencies (NACCRRA) child care is paid monthly directly to the child care provider. Once the corps members is accepted, child care information will be provided.
- Travel Paid to Program & Upon Successful Completion—A Greyhound Bus Ticket is purchased by TCCC for the corps members travel to our program and only upon successful completion.
- \$5,550 Education Award—Upon completion of 1,700 hours of volunteer community service hours, each member receives the AmeriCorps Education Award to be used for college or vocational school. Education loans can be deferred during service.

Qualifications:

- ☉ Age 17 through 24; (17 year olds with High School Diploma/GED)
- ☉ U.S. Citizens or legal resident
- ☉ Must be a Team Player and willing to change, adapt and prevent conflict in positive ways.
- ☉ Willing to serve for 9-months & complete at least 1,700 hours of community service
- ☉ Must Be Self-Motivated, Committed & Hard-working
- ☉ Must participate in every activity, including traveling.
- ☉ Able to pass a Drug & Alcohol Free Upon Entry & Test Random Thereafter.
- ☉ **Cannot already possess a Bachelor's or Master's Degree**

Education:

- ☉ If you do NOT have your High School Diploma or GED Equivalent, you must be willing to obtain one while in our program & prior to using the education award upon graduation.

Applicant will be subject to the Hoopa Valley Tribe's Fit For Duty Policy.

Applicant will be subject to a criminal background check.

Applicant can have no FELONYS which include Murder, Aggravated Assaults or any types of Sexual Crimes. All background checks are based on a case by case approval from the Program Director.
