

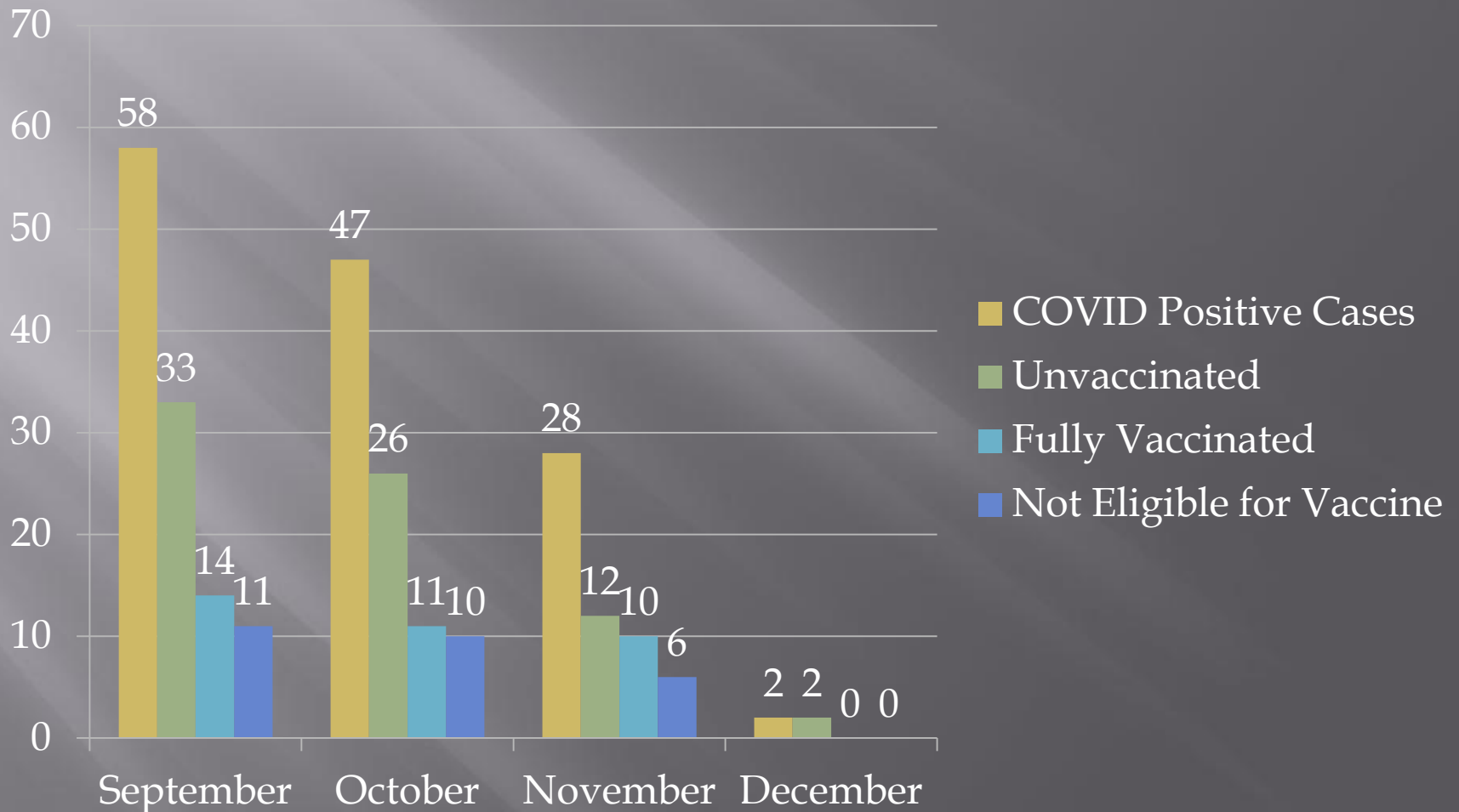

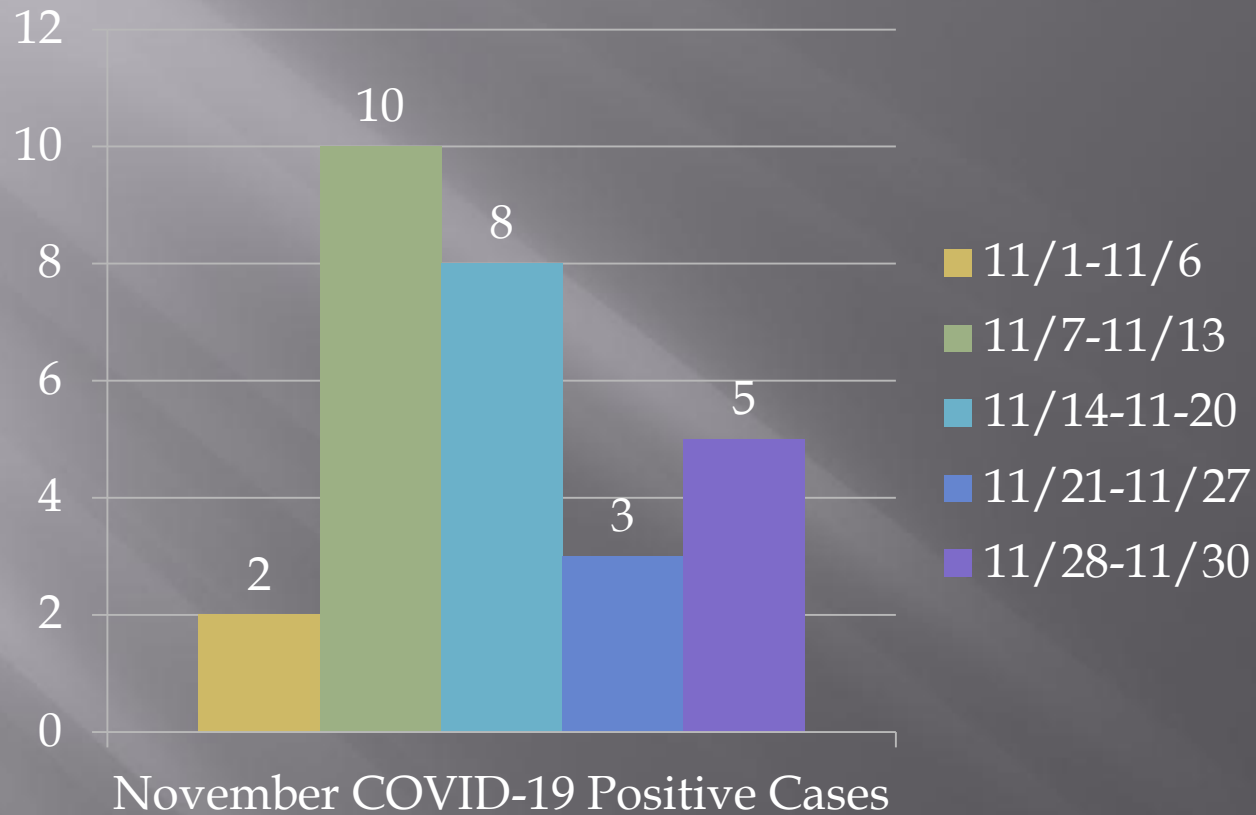
# COVID Cases To Date

- ▣ \*red: comparison from 11/9/21 report

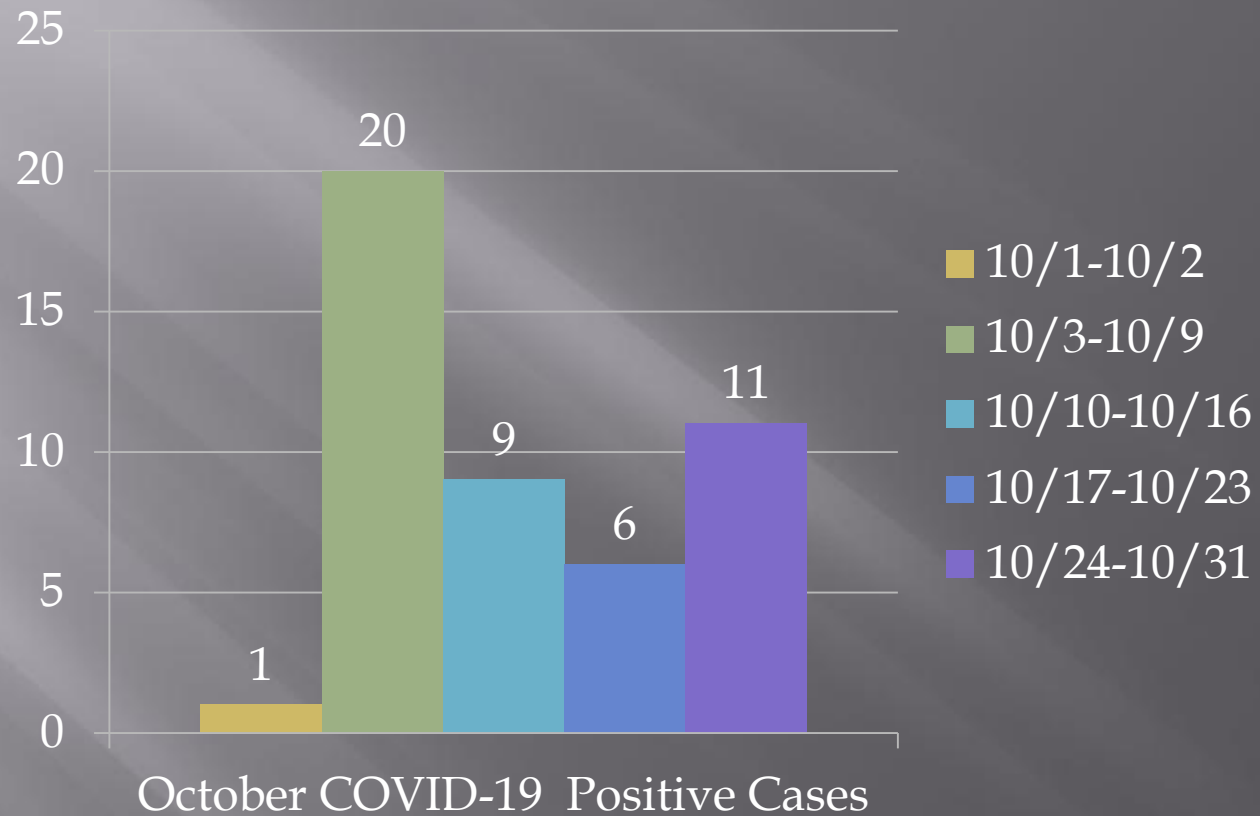
# COVID Positives Sept-Dec



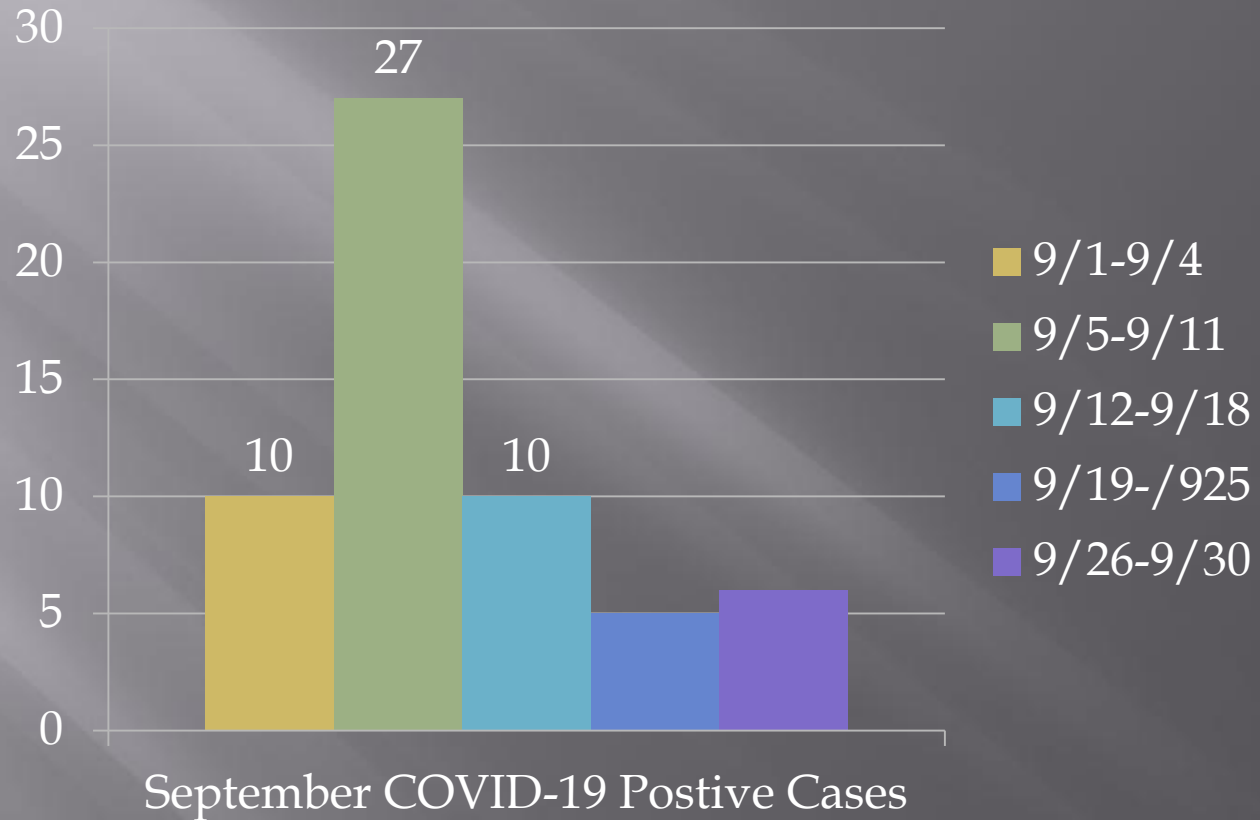
# November 2020 COVID-19 Positive Cases (28)

# Omicron Variant

- ▣ First reported in South Africa in early November.
- ▣ Currently detected in 20 countries, including 16 US States.
- ▣ Detected in California
- ▣ New information is being released daily

## What We Know:

- ▣ Has multiple mutations
- ▣ More aggressive than the Delta variant.
- ▣ Vaccinations and boosters remain our best defense against COVID, including the new variant.



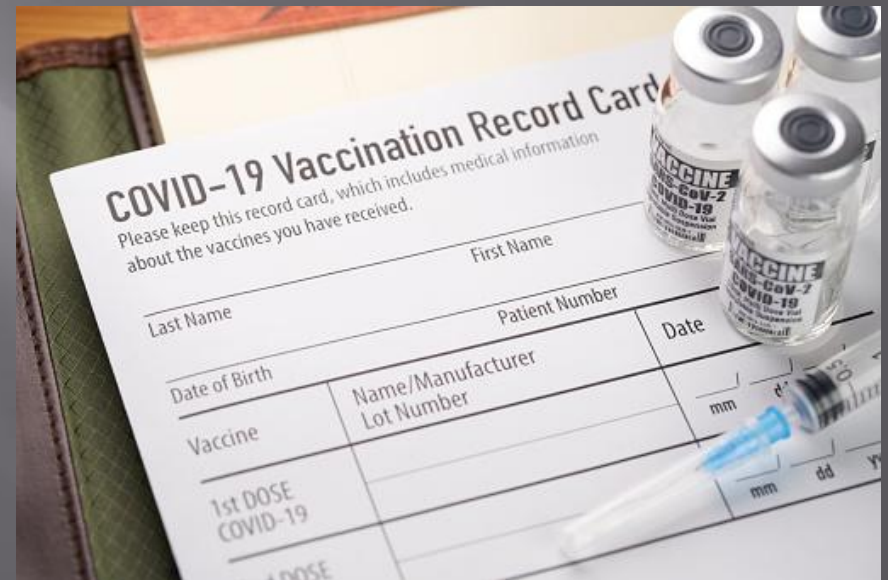
# Omicron Variant Continued

## Unknowns:

- ▣ Severity of illness
- ▣ How easily it will spread
- ▣ If current vaccines will work against it (current vaccines are expected to protect against severe illness and hospitalizations. There will most likely be breakthrough infections as with the other variants).

- ▣ Eligible 6 months after 2nd dose in the 2 dose series

## Johnson & Johnson's Janssen

Eligible 2 months after the single dose series
