WILDLIFE YOUTH SERVICE CORP. (8), Forestry Department. Temporary Full-time, Seasonal. Wages: \$23.00/hr. (Base rate)- \$27.00/hr. (Fire rate). The purpose of this position is to provide hands-on forestry experience to participants through cultural learning, and environmental education. The Youth Corp Service Members will engage in reforestation, vegetation management, and fuels reduction for National Forest System lands, particularly within ancestral Hupa Territory and the Tsemeta Nursery. Through mentorship from the Hoopa Tribal Forestry department, and U.S. Forest Service staff members will gain technical skills, traditional Ecological Knowledge (TEK) perspectives, and certifications that will prepare them for future careers in natural resources, Forestry and fire management. Participants can earn college credits through College of the Redwoods Klamath-Trinity Instructional Site, which may transfer to Cal Poly Humboldt.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be 16-24 years old.
- Capable of standing, walking, and carrying equipment for several hours a day.
- Must be a team player.
- Must be a high school student, or high school graduate.
- Must be comfortable performing tasks in various weather conditions, and adapting to changing conditions in the field or project assignments.
- Must be dependable, and punctual.
- Must be able to follow directions, ask questions and report observations clearly.

HVT Application Requirements: To be considered for a HVT position, applicants must submit the following verification: 1) A complete HVT Employment Application (a resume is optional but alone does not meet this requirement). 2) Official or unofficial transcripts from an accredited college or university verifying required education, if applicable. 3) Tribal verification must be attached if requesting Indian Preference. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
