



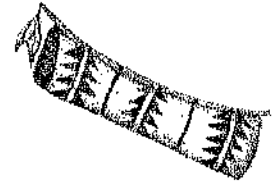

CONTINUING BUSINESS:

1. Motion to reaffirm Council Polling Sheet for OES. Motion to approve travel for RobRoy Latham Jr to attend the Tribal Training Week in Anniston, AL September 12, 2026 – September 19, 2026. - Chairman

Motion to accept Quartz Valley Indian Reservation Consortium Agreement PPG-Fund 104/FY27 Consort-A with the Hoopa Valley Tribe in the amount of \$21,000 allocated for laboratory fees associated with the Hoopa Valley Tribes sampling of baseline water quality studies on the Klamath river and related tributaries. Amount to be accepted into Hoopa Land Management account TBD. – Ken Norton (sponsored by: Carpenter)
10. Motion to approve and update bank signers. – Maybeline Peterson (sponsored by: Chairman)
13. Motion to accept the Department of Health and Human Services ACF NOA in the amount of \$2,829,416 for Head Start/Early Head Start, Head Start FY27 program year. Head Start Fund 3983 in the amount of \$1,174,201 and Early Head Start fund 3989 in the amount of \$1,655,215. – Angel Korb (sponsored by: Hailey)
